

User Agreement and Terms of Use for ilia.humanrightshouse.org

1. General Remarks. Concepts. Principles

These Rules constitute the agreement between the User and the HRHF on how to use the Resource and its functionality.

The website <https://ilia.humanrightshouse.org> serves as an information and training resource (the **Resource**). The rights to <https://ilia.humanrightshouse.org> belong to the Human Rights House Foundation (HRHF).

The owner of the Resource, the Human Rights House Foundation (the HRHF) is a non-governmental organization and a legal entity acting under the Norwegian law. The HRHF holds all rights or is the license holder or owner of the respective usage rights, in particular of the copyrights, over the Resource and the right to administer access to and use of the Resource, and all rights relating to the domain name <https://ilia.humanrightshouse.org>. The HRHF has its registered address at 5 Kirkegata str., 0153, Oslo, Norway.

As the Resource owner, the HRHF provides access to the Resource to users subject to the terms, conditions, obligations and rules stipulated in this document (the **Rules**). The HRHF is authorised to take all the necessary measures to protect the materials placed on the Resource from the possible destruction or unauthorized use.

As a user, you agree that any use of the Resource is subject to the Rules by choosing to use the Resource or any of its services, trainings, contents or features. Users who do not agree to the Rules will be asked to cease using the Resource and its materials.

The Resource combines the distance training courses of the educational project [Electronic Human Rights Education for Lawyers \(EHREL\)](#), the e-library, thematic workshops for the project alumni and other platforms enabling interaction between the program partners, participants and alumni.

The Resource is based on the following principles, which are fundamental for the access to and use of the Resource:

- The materials are provided for non-commercial educational purposes.
- Fair use of the Resource.

2. Users

A user is any person who visits the website <https://ilia.humanrightshouse.org>.

User categories:

Unregistered users;

Registered users.

Unregistered users (users who are not registered in the system).

For unregistered users, two types of access to the Resource content are available:

Free access

It requires no action from a user willing to access the Resource content open to free access. Free access is provided to the Resource home page, courses description and e-library catalogue.

Guest access

A user can view the Resource content open to guest access (courses, materials) for informational purposes. No other options are available. Using the guest access, a user must accept the terms of this user agreement every time.

Registered users (users who are registered in the system).

Registered users have the right to access the Resource content inaccessible to free access and guest access. The Resource owner, together with the partner, set the internal Resource policies defining the access levels and access rights for registered users. Users of this category accept the user agreement once, during the registration procedure.

Primarily, the following user categories may request for and be allowed access to the certain Resource content at <https://ilia.humanrightshouse.org>:

1. The alumni of the ILIA Program;
2. Representatives of the Human Rights Houses and their member organisation;
3. Representatives of other partner organizations of the ILIA program - upon a request to the HRHF.
4. Students of the Resource courses and workshops.

In any case, the rules regulating the user access to the certain Resource content will be set based on the policy of the content owner/ copyright holder.

3. User Responsibilities

When using the Resource, the User undertakes:

1. not to post any false personal information on the Resource or create an account on behalf of another person without the proper authorisation;
2. not to create more than one personal account;
3. not to transfer their password or provide access to their account to others;
4. to provide the exact contact information and to update it in a timely manner;
5. only place on the Resource information that is consistent with the objectives of the Resource, and which does not infringe on the interests of other users;
6. not to post materials which infringe or violate someone's rights or laws, namely, not to upload to, or distribute or otherwise publish on the Resource any libellous, defamatory, obscene, abusive, or otherwise illegal material. The User agrees that they will not

threaten other users, use defamatory language, or deliberately disrupt discussions with spam.

When using the Resource, the User agrees with the following:

1. All the materials placed on the Resource, including but not limited to logos, button-
icons, pictures, glossaries, slides, digital downloads, videos or texts are protected
rights, e.g. are protected by copyright, and are either owned by the Operator or its
licensors or suppliers.
2. Any Intellectual Property Right items, services, content and material that are
available on the Resource are generally provided only for educational purposes and
exclusively for non-commercial and personal use by the User.
3. The Resource content and Intellectual Property Right items may not be reproduced,
copied, collected, organised, stored, or transferred to create a database, regardless of
the method of use, for any public or commercial purpose, without the consent of the
HRHF.
4. Users may use the content provided they attribute all the copyright or other notices of
ownership, and they ensure that the author's name and the product are preserved
intact and are used for non-commercial purposes only.
5. Users are solely responsible for the content of any of their submissions. The HRHF
is not responsible for the content of any submission and reserves the right to remove,
move or edit any materials or information posted by Users on the Resource if the
HRHF believes that the material or information submitted violates the Rules set out
in this document, or any applicable copyright or trademark, or any other applicable
law, in its sole discretion;
6. In case of violation of Intellectual Property Rights or other rights, the User will be
put on notice after the first violation, and after the second violation, the User's
account will be blocked without the right to restore it;
7. The User is personally responsible for verifying this Agreement for amendments;
8. The User is aware of inherent security risks of providing information and dealing
online over the Internet.

4. Responsibilities of HRHF in Terms of Personal Data Protection

The HRHF respects the privacy of all Users of the Resource and will take all the necessary measures to protect the User's personal data against any unauthorised access, alteration, use, disclosure or destruction.

The HRHF provides access to the User's personal data only to those HRHF employees, who need this information to ensure the operation of the Resource and to provide access to the Resource for the User.

Unless the User has proven otherwise, any action taken with the use of the User's login and password will be deemed to be committed by the User. In case of unauthorised access to the

User's login and password and/or personal page, or a disclosure of the User's login and password, the User is obliged to immediately inform the HRHF about it.

5. Legal Nature of Rules and Legal Consequences for Parties

These Rules constitute the agreement between the User and the HRHF on how to use the Resource and its functionality.

These Rules enter into force as soon as the User accepts this agreement. The Rules are effective for an indefinite period.

If for any reason one or more provisions of these Rules are declared invalid or void, this will not affect the validity or enforceability of the remaining provisions.
